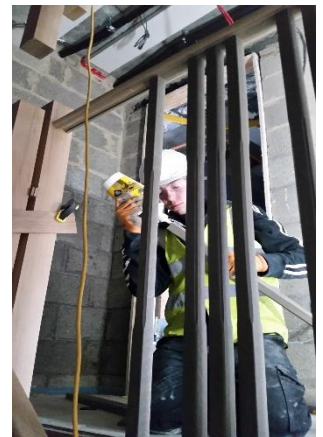




Case Study - Apprentices

In August 2016 and whilst looking for an apprenticeship in carpentry, Albert was introduced to J A Stott Carpentry Ltd via St James and London Borough of Hounslow's REDe department as a work experience placement. After a successful interview and positive feedback from his 2 weeks work experience at Fitzroy Gate, Isleworth project we were able to offer Albert an apprenticeship contract.

Whilst attending college 1 day a week, Albert works alongside our carpenters assisting them in installation of general joinery & carpentry items such as fascia, cladding, handrails, insulation, creating stud walls.
